

Workshop #3: Solutions NOT Suspensions

Students cannot learn if they are faced with school policies that consistently push them out of school and into a pipeline to prison. During this workshop, participants will the opportunity to explore a new initiative that invests in programs which improve student success in school and reduce reliance on incarceration, such as restorative justice. Participants will also have the opportunity to hear the experiences of youth that have gone through the system. These experiences underscore the need to invest in supportive schools that keep our communities safe. Participants should expect to leave the workshop having a clear understanding of what *Supportive Schools, Safe Communities* is, and how they can help raise awareness and public will around the issue.
