# Five Ways S.3036/A.3873 will help break New York's School to Prison Pipeline

---

1

End suspensions for K-3 students

2

Restorative justice and other alternative discipline in place of harsh and ineffective removals from school

3

Students who are suspended can get back on track by limiting the amount of time that a student can be out of school to 20 days and by providing access to work and alternative instruction during the suspension.

4

Stop inappropriate interactions between school resource officers and students

5

Make sure all of the adults that students interact with have training of best practices in creating safe, healthy, and inclusive schools.
