Provides no funding for pre-K in this year 's budget after promise of universal pre-K.

Last year promised pre-K for every four year old throughout the state but only delivered for 5% in upstate and suburban communities.

Does not understand the difference between basic mathematical concepts of equity and averages.

Spending gap between rich and poor schools has grown to record setting \$8,733 per pupil under his leadership.

Does not grasp basic math concepts such as the fact that "universal" pre-K would mean serving every four year old.

He continues to set fundraising records among hedge funds managers and other wealthy donors.



Unable to provide a grade as these programs have been cut for his grade level.
